



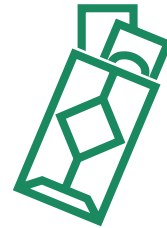
NRPP PROGRAM ROADMAP TO FUNDING

This document is intended to help clients in the NRPP program plan funding requests. It explains the process of requesting funding and how much money is available for each type of request.

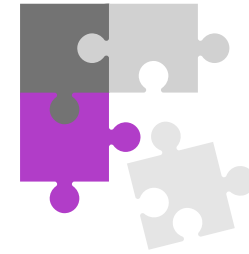
ELIGIBILITY



Financial assistance in the NRPP program is based on need.



Clients who already have a high income are invited to enroll in the program but are not eligible for financial assistance.



This is because some people need more assistance than others, and NRPP seeks to meet everyone's needs accurately.

- Granting funds to a client who does not need them makes those funds unavailable to someone who does.

NRPP FUNDING REQUEST ROADMAP

Identify a need

Step
#1

Work with your case manager to identify the steps to meet your need.

Up to one month for request processing after documents are submitted

Step
#2

If the need is eligible for funding, your case manager will explain what documents you must submit, including:

- Proof of cost and vendor
- Proof of payment for reimbursement

Step
#3

Your case manager will email the request to USCRI. USCRI reviews requests weekly and will send a decision or request more information.

Your case manager will update you on the decision.



FUNDING AMOUNTS

Please note: The following are established request categories. If you have different needs, please discuss them with your case manager.

Upward Mobility Up to two of the following:

- Up to \$4,000 toward the purchase of a car
 - Up to the average cost of CDL training in each region (see next page)
 - Career training up to \$3,000
 - Materials to support training or start a career, up to \$3,000
 - Debt repayment up to \$3,000
 - Up to 26 therapy sessions, if not covered by health insurance.
- AND:** Payment of immigration fees, in total
- AND:** Up to \$6,500 for dental work, plus the cost of a dental savings plan (usually ~\$150/year)

Emergency Assistance Must have 50% or less of [Area Medium Income](#)

- Up to two months of living expenses in the event of an emergency.
Please note that quitting a job does not qualify as an emergency except in exceptional circumstances
- OR: Medical bills up to \$4,000. Clients should apply for hospital financial assistance to reduce bills first, allowing NRPP assistance to go further.
- OR: Moving costs not including transportation, up to \$3,000
- OR: Other emergency expenses, up to \$3,000
